

Special Needs for Tierra Nueva 2006

Above its normal operating costs, Tierra Nueva in San Luis needs funds for the following projects. If you are interested in funding all or part of these projects or are interested in more information, send Larry Sell an email at lsell2@earthlink.net. Make sure you indicate Tierra Nueva in the subject space.

- 1) \$1000 is needed to fix up the meeting house. The house Tierra Nueva uses for meetings and courses as well as lodging for farmers and promoters when they are in the town of San Luis is badly in need of repairs.
- 2) \$600 to buy 500 avocado trees @ \$1.20 each. These will be sold to farmers, however we need the money to buy them up front. This will enable us to get some needed varieties into the area to have for grafting stock.
- 3) \$100 to buy tools for a blind furniture maker – that's right, a blind furniture maker. In the village of Coyolitos there is a blind man who provides for his family making furniture. There are a couple of tools he badly needs. A quality block plane is one of them. The promoters have priced the tools in the city.

If you send any donations they should be sent to Larry Sell with the checks made out to **Tierra Nueva**. On the bottom MEMO line put **HONDURAN PROJECT, SAN LUIS**.
